## Dear Chair Mallory:

As you know, President Biden's plan to secure environmental justice specifically called for "prioritizing substitutes through procurement" to address forever chemicals, or per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS). As the administration moves to improve the government procurement process, we strongly support and urge the Council on Environmental Quality to take actions to end unnecessary exposures to these toxic forever chemicals.

Our understanding is that the Council on Environmental Quality is finalizing an Executive Order (EO) to guide sustainable procurement by the federal government. It is important to human health and the environment that any final EO includes a requirement directing federal agencies to look for items that do not include PFAS chemicals as an intentionally-added ingredient when making purchases during the government procurement process.

As you finalize the order, we urge you to ensure this order includes a specific purchasing directive to avoid products made with harmful PFAS chemicals. We also urge CEQ to ensure that the order includes a requirement that other agencies follow the EPA's guidelines when making purchases, as well as a requirement to report back to the White House on these efforts. As Members of Congress focused on efforts to reduce needless exposures to PFAS, we applaud the President for his commitment to prioritizing products that have not been made with PFAS as an ingredient.

We are grateful for the President's efforts to address PFAS so far with the release of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's release of the PFAS Strategic Roadmap. During his campaign, President Biden pledged to address PFAS in three ways: by setting a PFAS drinking water standard, by designating PFAS as hazardous substances, and by prioritizing alternatives to PFAS during procurement. The Biden-Harris Administration has made important progress on the two of these commitments.

We urge you to fulfill the President's commitment on the third by adding PFAS to the final sustainable procurement Executive Order. Thank you in advance for your attention and consideration of this important request.
