

**A BILL**

To amend the consumer product safety laws to repeal of exclusion of pistols, revolvers, and other firearms from the definition of consumer product under such laws.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Defective Firearms  
5 Protection Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF EXCLUSION OF PISTOLS, REVOLVERS,**  
2 **AND OTHER FIREARMS.**

3 (a) DEFINITION OF CONSUMER PRODUCT.—Section  
4 3(a)(5) of the Consumer Product Safety Act (15 U.S.C.  
5 2052(a)(5)) is amended by striking subparagraph (E).

6 (b) RULEMAKING AUTHORITY.—Section 3 of the  
7 Consumer Product Safety Commission Improvements Act  
8 of 1976 (15 U.S.C. 2079) is amended by striking sub-  
9 section (e) and redesignating subsection (f) as subsection  
10 (e).
