I am requesting funding for the Water Street Site Remediation in fiscal year 2023. The entity to receive funding for this project is Washtenaw County, located at 220 N Main Street, Ann Arbor, MI 48104.

The funding will support the completion of remediation of the 38-acre Water Street site in Ypsilanti, MI. This site is heavily contaminated with lead and PCBs from past industrial operations, making the site unattractive for private redevelopment. Complete site remediation makes the site attractive for redevelopment and allows productive economic, residential, and recreational use of a critical property. Redevelopment is a long-term goal and would significantly contribute to the life and future of the City and County.
